Group B then took a short walk to **Harrods**, one of the largest department stores in the world, with over 300 departments! Its most famous sections include the jewellery section, designer brand stores, and the giant food hall, where students could try out the array of food and drink on offer!

After a busy day for both groups, the students reconvened back in Cambridge for some evening activities back in college.
