IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Full-Time Undergraduates and Post Graduates

If you are a full-time student applying to work for Reach Cambridge under a student visa please be advised that you cannot work:

- more than 20 hours a week during term time; or
- full-time during vacations unless you are eligible for settlement (also called 'indefinite leave to remain')

All Part-Time Students, Those Studying Below Graduate Level and at a Private Provider

You are not allowed to work in the UK without a visa.

WE REGRET THAT WE CAN ONLY ACCEPT YOUR APPLICATION FOR EMPLOYMENT IF YOUR VISA ALLOWS US TO

Can Reach Cambridge sponsor my student visa?

We are sometimes asked if we can sponsor international students and regrettably, we cannot. The UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI) service, which is an operational command of the Home Office, has a very strict regime for education providers wishing to apply for, and hold a licence to sponsor international students to come to the UK under student visa arrangements.

Whilst we provide short-term education experiences for students aged 14 to 18, we fall outside the UKVI's definition of an 'education provider' – which typically includes private schools, colleges of higher education and universities teaching undergraduate and postgraduate courses of study on a full- or part-time basis.

We are therefore unable to apply for and attain sponsorship status under these arrangements.
