Reach Cambridge enables students to prepare for the future by offering the international experience of a lifetime within a fun, nurturing and academically enriching community.

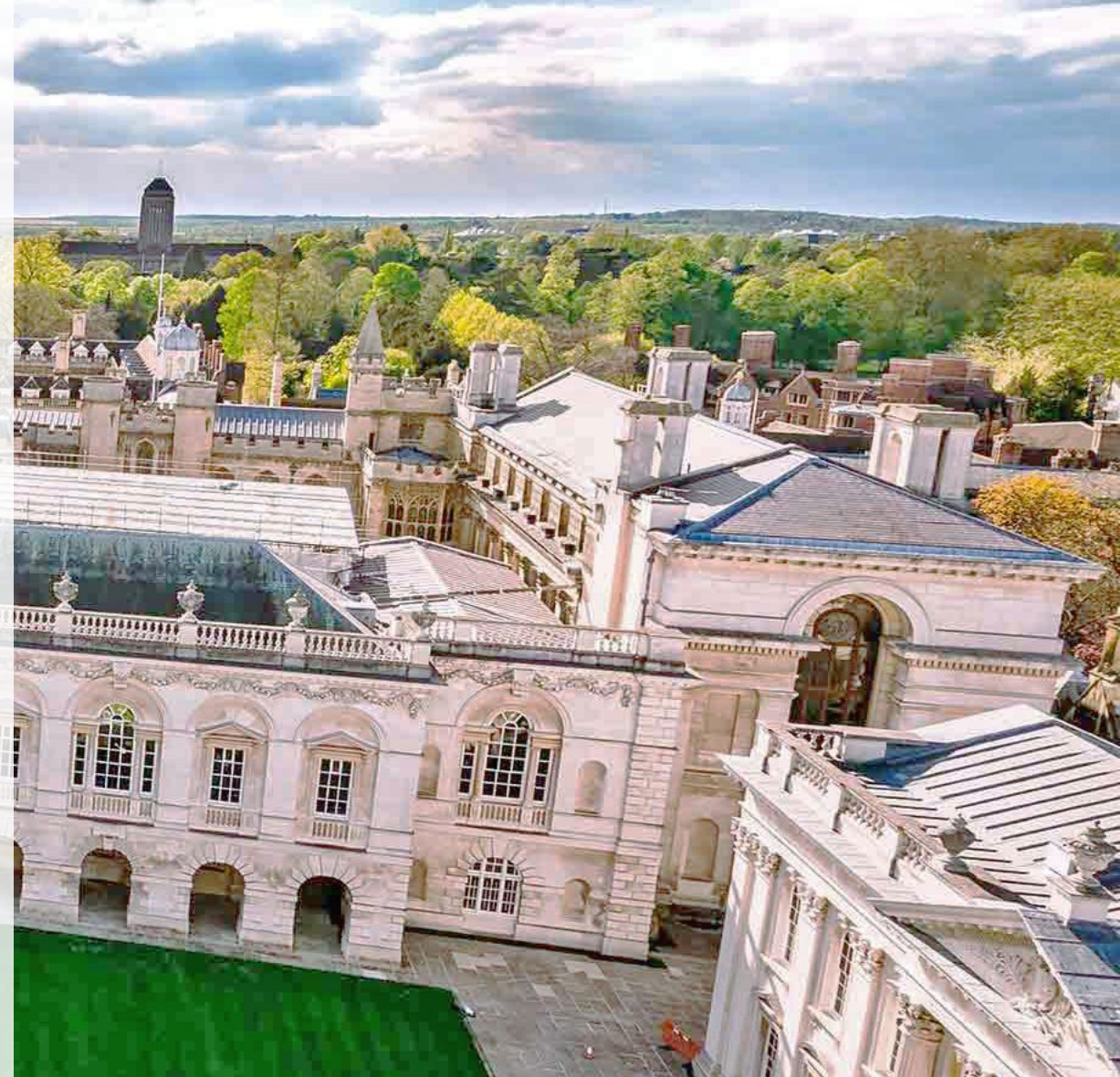
Our programs are designed to engage, challenge and inspire young minds, and year on year we work with a diverse group of gifted young people to achieve that goal.

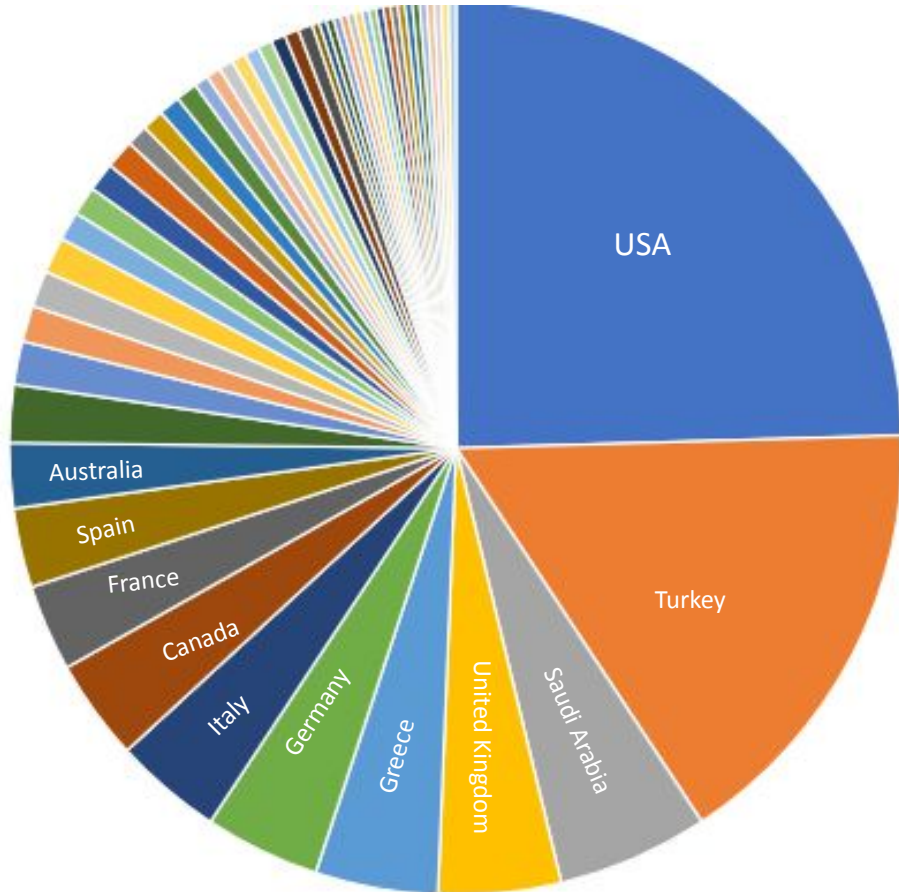

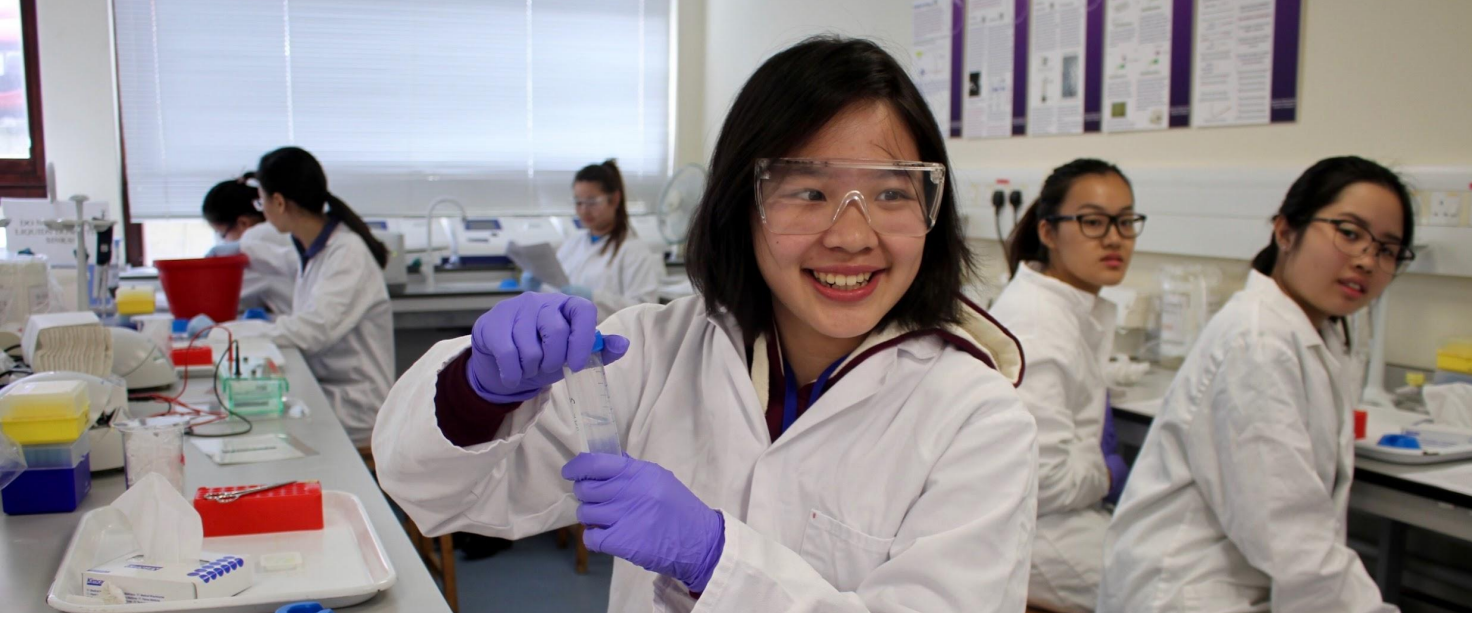

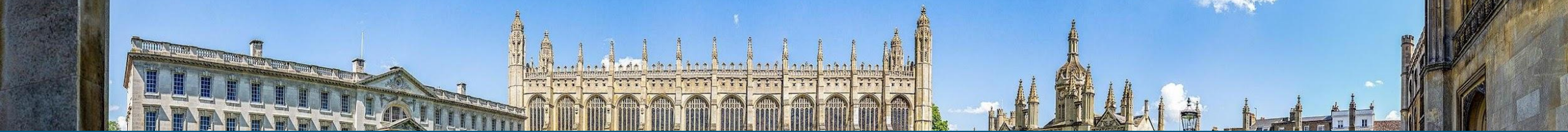
Interdisciplinary Day
